

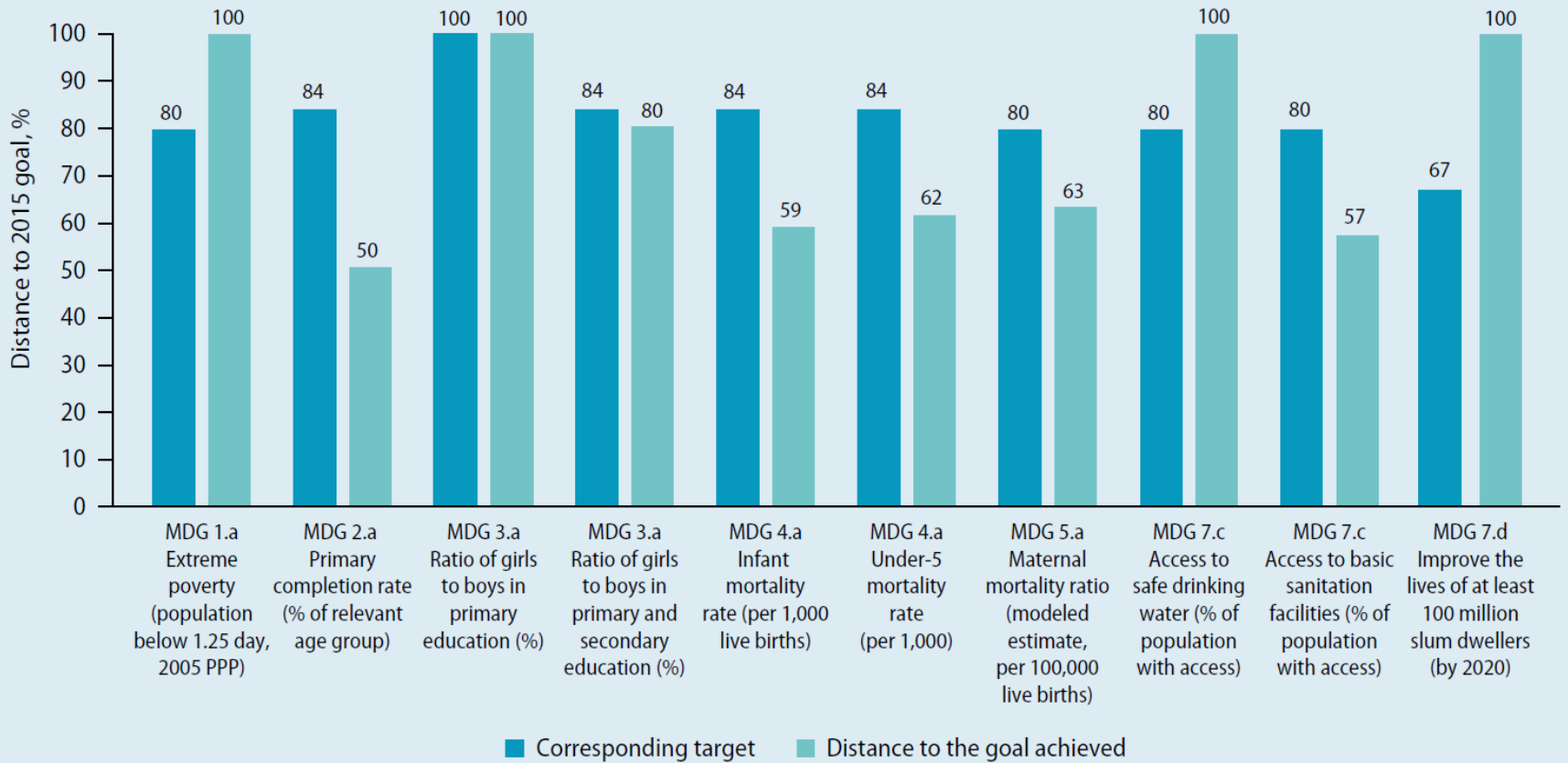

Reduce **infant and maternal mortality**

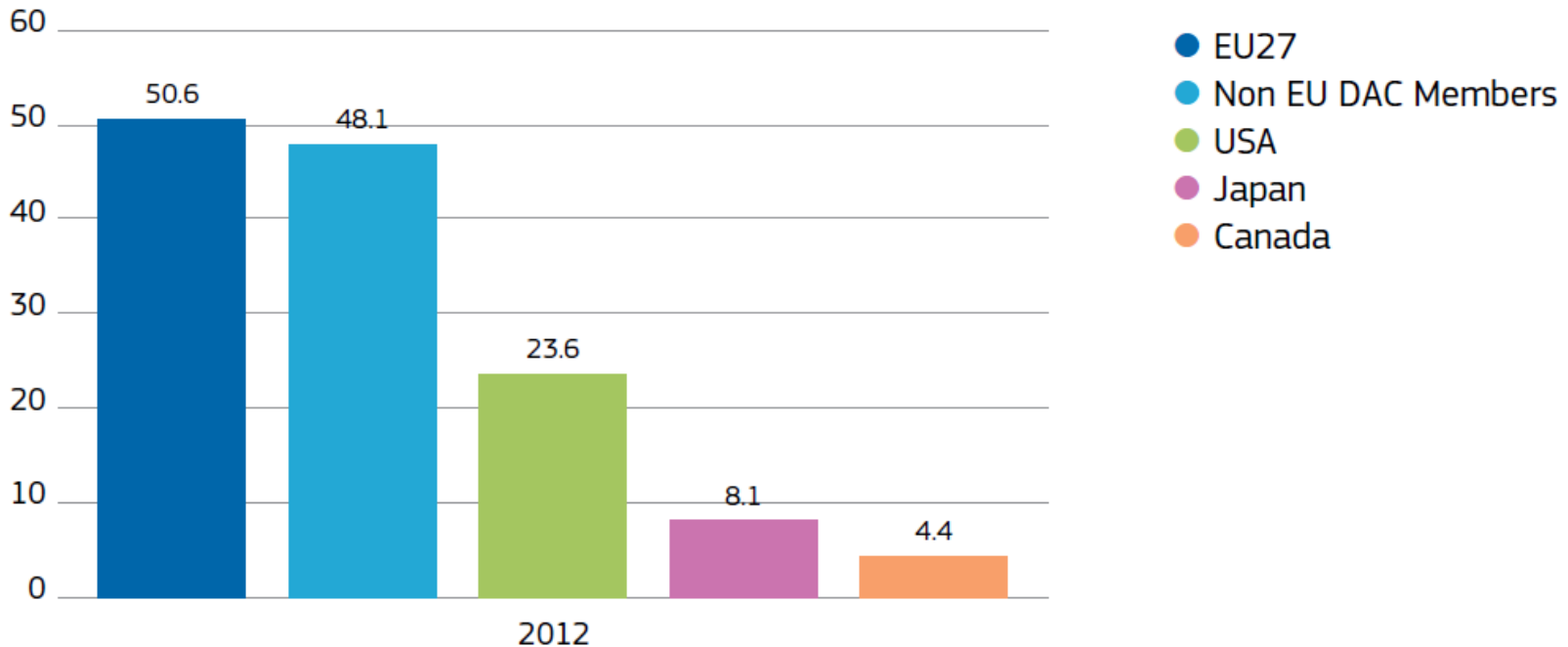


Halve the proportion of the population without **access to basic sanitation**

1. An **integrated and comprehensive** agenda combining poverty eradication and sustainable development
2. An **universal** agenda - adapted to national situations
3. A **consultative** process - towards a global partnership
